

IST AG DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY TO THE "TOXIC SUBSTANCE CONTROL ACT"

The United States Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) is a federal chemicals management regulation.

The Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) authorizes the EPA to regulate and screen all chemicals produced or imported into the United States to prevent unreasonable risks to health and the environment.

On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published new regulations under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h) to restrict the import and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals.

In general, a TSCA certificate is not required for products, however, the new PBT rule prohibits the manufacture (including import), processing and commercial distribution of five PBT chemicals/substances or products or articles containing the defined PBT chemicals/substances.
